Our organization is once again excited to be hosting the Cornshucker Spring League in 2012. This is the eighth year of the spring league. We continue to look for ways to improve the spring league for teams each year. The goal of our spring league is pretty simple: **provide baseball players with competitive game opportunities in preparation of the upcoming season.**

Over the years, many teams in the spring league have used the league as a 'spring training' for their teams. As high school coaches, we recognize that the spring time is always a difficult period to get players together to begin preparations for the season as there are many other activities occurring during this time.

The spring league provides a number of flexible options for individuals or teams. Based on your feedback, we have added options this year for teams to play games during the week or continue to play games on the weekends. Teams can also choose a combination of dates based on their availability. **We are also providing a 12 or 18 game schedules this year.** Teams playing 18 games will play games during the week and/or both days on weekends.

The weeknight option allows some teams to compete in the spring league play and participate in weekend tournaments. This option will be provided as long as we have more than two teams opting to play during the week. We will continue to use time limits of 1:45 per game in 2012 as well.

We are grateful for the opportunity to continue to use top-notch high school facilities in the area for the spring league.

## 2012 Spring League Details

- 8th year of spring league – more than 250 players participated in 2011 spring league.
- Baseball players completing grades 8 through 12 by the end of the 2011-2012 school year are eligible to participate.
- 12 game or 18 game schedules available.
- \*Ages for each division are included as a guideline ONLY. Teams may choose to play in an older division if appropriate.
- Teams play doubleheaders. Each game has seven inning or 1:45 time limit (USSSA rule).
- **\*\*Teams have option** in 2012 to play games on weekends or during the week. (Games played on weeknights only if two or more teams are available. While every effort will be made to match playing date preferences, teams must be available to play on those preferred dates in order to have games.)
- Rain dates scheduled throughout the season when possible—including April 7 and May 12-13.
- Iowa High School Athletic Association (IAHSAA) 2012 Rules will be enforced. IAHSAA licensed umpires used.
- Continuous batting order and free defensive substitutions allowed.
- Score is kept for games, but all teams receive same number of USSSA points for league participation.
- Individual, partial team and full team sign-up options are available for league. Team roster sizes unlimited.
- League fee covers umpire, use of facilities, baseballs and player shirts.
- Efforts will be made to schedule teams around potential conflicts with other activities. However, conflicts need to be communicated to league coordinator prior to March 10, 2012. No exceptions!
- Each team is responsible for providing coaches, scorekeepers and all other baseball equipment. Coaches must be over 18 years of age and have valid drivers' license.
- 12 game schedule—teams guaranteed four playing dates. 18 game schedule—teams guaranteed seven playing dates. Partial refund policy applies if teams play less than guaranteed dates. Refunds issued to high school baseball program of participant. Teams choosing not to make-up games are not eligible for partial refund policy.
- All registrations must be submitted at same time if registering as a team. Teams must submit one check as individual players' checks for a team will not be accepted. (A return check fee of \$75.00 will be assessed for all team or individual returned checks.)
